The Kamchad Mongkolkul Resource Center is named after Assoc. Prof.

Kamchad Mongkolkul, the first Director of The Petroleum and Petrochemical College. The Resource Center specifically serves industries that collaborate with the College.

The Library at PPC was established in 1992 and caters specifically to the petrochemical, polymer, plastics, surfactants, catalysis, and related fields in support of the PPC curriculum in its three majors: Petroleum Technology, Petrochemical Technology, and Polymer Science. In 2009, the library area was extended to 700 square meters, with new furniture and more services for its users.

## Location

The Resource Center and Library are located on the 8<sup>th</sup> floor of The Petroleum and Petrochemical College - Metallurgy and Materials Research Institute building, Soi Chulalongkorn 12, Phayathai Road, Patumwan, Bangkok 10330.

## Collections

The Library houses a wide range of textbooks, academic journals, reference books, theses, standards, videos, clippings, company profiles, and so forth. It provides more than 2,950 textbooks, 1,130 theses, and 15 foreign journals. Back issues have been formed into bound journals, with about 1,500 copies in English and 95 in Thai. More than 2,900 DVDs recorded from classes are a large part of our collection to serve our students.

#### **Facilities**

## - English Self-Access Learning Room

The Library provides a room for English practice, which includes three stations for the Audio-Visual Lab for students who wish to improve their English skills. Many types of materials are available for use: videos, CDs and cassette tapes, movies, and an extensive collection of TOEFL, TOEIC, GRE, and CU-TEP preparation and test books, and graded readers.

#### - Internet Corner

The Library provides computers and Wi-Fi to facilitate the work of the College's students for multiple purposes, e.g. thesis work and information searching through the Internet.

## **Circulation Rules**

- 1. Please use your own library card when borrowing books.
- Undergraduate and graduate students can borrow up to three textbooks at a time. Ph.D. students can borrow up to five items (7 days per item). Lecturers (PPC) can borrow up to seven items (15 days per item). All users can renew one time through the internet.
- 3. The library will reserve books that are recommended by lecturers for their classes. Students can borrow them for a limited time (1-3 days per item) (only one reserved book is allowed to be borrowed at any given time).
- 4. Journals and reference books *cannot be removed* from the library.
- 5. Please borrow books no later than 15 minutes before closing time.

**Fines**: The charge for overdue textbooks is **3 baht** per day and **30 baht** per day for theses and reserved books.
