



PPC Guidelines for Graduate Studies Regulations for Re-admission

Referring to the 20108 CU Graduate Studies Regulations No. 33 “Applicants whose status as a graduate student has been terminated after having completed their studies specified in the curriculum of a program of study but have failed to graduate or after failing to maintain the minimum cumulative grade required may gain RE-ADMISSION to the same program of study only at the DISCRETION of the Graduate Studies Committee”. From this regulation, it is deduced into

1. The dismissal students enable to be re-admitted are those who
 - 1.1 Study longer than the maximum time allowed for their status plus twice the extended time requested and no longer get approval for maintaining student status¹
 - 1.2 Finish all graduation requirements except “Proof of English Proficiency” and/or “Two Internationally Published Papers with peer-review”²
2. The program administrative committee³ will consider whether to render an approval or not. Finally, the PPC Executive board will approve the results from the program administrative committee.⁴

Referring to the 2018 CU Graduate Studies Regulations No. 52 and No. 47

3. The Re-admission will grant the dismissal students on
 - 3.1 All coursework credits taken not more than 5 years are transferable but not more than 1/3 of total coursework credit requirement and accordingly, the grade of those transferred credits must be “S” or at least “B” and GPA not less than 3.0.⁵
 - 3.2 Their results of *passing qualifying exam*⁶ and/or English proficiency test are still valid.
 - 3.3 Having the same dissertation advisor and proceeding with the former topic but with the new proposal submission and presentation in the first month of the first semester.
 - 3.4 The Re-admitted students may register more than 15 credits per semester if it is allowed by the program administrative committee.⁷
4. Tuition fee of 31,000 bahts per semester⁸ must be paid before the registration period.
