Invigilation and Applying Honor Practice during Doctorate Qualifying Exam

According to the resolution of Petroleum and Petrochemical College's Executive Board from the meeting no. 1/2563 on February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 to establish the students' honor practice by pursuing all academic endeavors with integrity, Petroleum and Petrochemical College (PPC) announces that the students conduct themselves honorably and respectfully as self-regulated in order to ensure an atmosphere of dignity and trust. Therefore, the invigilation duty during doctorate qualifying examination (DQE) is changed and the students' honor practice is applied.

Students are aware of the following:

Under the honor practice, the students assume full responsibility for honesty in DQE written examination.

1. The invigilator is not required to stay all the time in the exam room. The examination is still allowed without the invigilator in the exam room.
2. The invigilator may come to investigate the exam room occasionally.
3. Exam instruction is announced or provided in the question sheets. It is not allowed to ask any questions during the examination.
4. On each examination answer paper, the student writes out and signs the following Honor Code: "I pledge on my honor that I alone have completed the DQE Exam and I have neither given nor received any unauthorized aid during this examination."
5. Violation to the honor practice during the examination both inside and outside the examination room results in failure to the exam.
