### Announcement

Subject: Master's Thesis Examination Committee for Curriculum 2018

The Petroleum and Petrochemical College announces the rule to appoint the committee for Master's Thesis Examination as approved by the College's Executive Committee in the 2/2563 meeting on February 27<sup>th</sup>, 2020 in order to maintain the higher education standards for postgraduate study, particularly for the newly amended programs in year 2018.

A thesis examination for Master program is aimed at measuring a student's knowledge and understanding of learnt theories and skills involved in the research topic, construction process, approaches, and techniques in applying or solving possible problems in his/her research.

A thesis examination shall be conducted by a Thesis Examination Committee. Thesis Examination Committee for a master degree program being appointed by Dean must be not less than 3 members, which comprise:

- (1) A Program Faculty Member who has knowledge and expertise on that particular research area as a Chairman of the committee
- (2) At least one person from External Scholars or Experts from outside the University as a committee
- (3) Both thesis Advisor and a Co-Advisor (if any) are counted as one committee member

In certain cases, a committee may consist of more members from the program or full-time faculty members. The quality of each particular committee has to follow the Education Ministry Announcement of the Standard Regulations for Graduate Study in year 2015.

All are valid for Master students ID61xxxxxxx onwards.
