

Bio Christoph Weder

Christoph Weder is Professor for Polymer Chemistry and Materials and Director of the Adolphe Merkle Institute (AMI) at the University of Fribourg (Switzerland). Chris studied Chemistry at ETH Zurich, where he also earned his doctoral degree in Polymer Science. After a postdoctoral stay at MIT, he held a lecturer position at ETH Zurich and a professorship at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland (USA), before joining the AMI in 2009. Chris remains an Adjunct Professor at Case Western Reserve University and has been a Visiting Professor at Chulalongkorn University's PPC (Bangkok) since 2003. He is the founding director of the Swiss National Center of Competence in Research *Bio-Inspired Materials*, which he directed from 2014 to 2020. His current research efforts focus on stimuli-responsive polymers and nanomaterials. Chris co-authored almost 300 research papers and book chapters, is co-inventor of twenty patent families, and has mentored about 55 PhD students and 40 postdoctoral scholars. He serves as an Associate Editor of *ACS Macro Letters*, co-Editor of the *RSC Book Series Polymer Chemistry*, is an Editorial Board Member of several journals, and co-director of the Swiss Chemical Society's Polymer and Colloid Division. Chris is a member of the Swiss Academy of Technical Sciences and a Fellow of the American Chemical Society's Division of Polymer Chemistry.
