Announcement of Measure Regarding Extension of Study and Tuition Fee for student with Scholarship under an Extraordinary Circumstance as a Result of the COVID-19 Pandemic

According to Chulalongkorn University announcement on the relief measure due to the closure of the university premises resulting from the spread of COVID-19 during the first semester of Academic Year 2021 by allowing student to apply for a leave of absence in the first semester of the 2021 academic year (The period of this leave of absence will not be counted as the student's accumulated period of study and fees for maintaining student status will also be waived). Regrettably, there are students who were receiving scholarships, such as Chulalongkorn University's Graduate Scholarship Program for ASEAN or Non-ASEAN Countries, C2F-PhD Scholarship, etc., and were unable to make use of the relief measure due to the commitment to the scholarship source. The College has carefully considered and believed that it is important to issue a further measure regarding extension of study time and tuition fee exemption for student with scholarship who were affected by the University closure resulting from the spread of COVID-19.

Student who was unable to apply for a leave of absence in the first semester of the 2021 academic year due to their commitment to the scholarship source may apply for one semester extension and receive tuition fee exemption to compensate for their opportunity loss during the closure. Student wishing to apply for this extension and exemption should submit the request form to the Academic Affairs.

This measure shall be taken into effect from now onwards.
