Application Procedure for the ASEAN and Non-ASEAN Scholarship for the 2nd Semester, Academic Year 2025 (Starting January 2026)

(This procedure applies only to applicants to The Petroleum and Petrochemical College, Chulalongkorn University)

1. Applicants must check their eligibility as follows:

- 1.1 The applicant must have a GPA on a 4.00 scale only.
 - If the applicant's institution does not use the 4.00 GPA system, the GPA must be converted to a 4.00 scale with official certification from the home university or the registrar's office.
 - Master's degree applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.75.
 - o Doctoral degree applicants must have a **minimum GPA of 2.75** at the Bachelor's level and **3.25** at the Master's level.
- **1.2** Applicants must demonstrate good English proficiency with one of the following minimum scores:
 - TOEFL (ITP): **500**, or
 - TOEFL (CBT): **173**, or
 - TOEFL (iBT): **61**, or
 - IELTS: 5.0
- **1.3** Application must not be over 40 years of age.
- **1.4** Applicants must be in good physical and mental health.



- From September 5, 2025 to October 13, 2025 only

Important: The applicant's name and all documents must be uploaded to the GrantGateway system in order for PPC to nominate them for the scholarship. If the applicant's name and documents are not in the system, nomination **cannot proceed**.

- **2.2** Documents to be uploaded to the GrantGateway system include:
 - One recent 1-inch photo
 - A Curriculum Vitae (CV)
 - A complete academic transcript issued by the last academic institution attended o (Must be on a 4.00 scale. If not, GPA must be converted to a 4.00 scale with official certification from the home university or registrar's office)
 - A certificate of graduation, if available
 - A photocopy of passport (valid for at least 2 years)
